**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION AND COMING INTO OPERATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY THE WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL WOKINGHAM FOOTPATH 40 DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2023**

On 11th March 2024 Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council"), confirmed the above named Order as an unopposed Order which modifies The Wokingham Borough Council Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(e)(i) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in either map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the maps relate, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A of the Act, a byway open to all traffic.

The effect of the confirmed Order is described in the Schedule below and modifies the definitive map and statement as described in the Schedule below.

### SCHEDULE PART I - Modification of Definitive Map Description of paths or ways to be added

A footpath commencing at the boundary of the Wokingham Borough Council owned land known as Fox Hill a point at Grid Reference 478915, 168352, and proceeding in a north-westerly direction over a ditch to for 2 metres to a point at Grid Reference 478914, 168353 before turning in a south-westerly direction 122 metres to a point at Grid Reference 478835, 168294 and continuing in a generally southerly direction for 260 metres to a point at Grid Reference 478726, 168309 and turning in a south-easterly direction to the boundary of the Wokingham Borough Council owned land known as Fox Hill to a point at Grid Reference 478970, 168069.

On 11th March 2024 Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council") confirmed the above named order as an unopposed Order which modifies The Wokingham Borough Council Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(e)(i) and (ii) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in either map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the maps relate, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A of the Act, a byway open to all traffic, and that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The effect of the confirmed Order is described in the Schedule below and will modify the definitive map and statement as described in the Schedule below.

A bridleway commencing at Highlands Avenue at its junction with Bearwood Road to a point at Grid Reference 478358, 168067, and proceeding in an easterly direction along Highlands Avenue for 455 metres to the junction of Wokingham Footpath 1 at the boundary between Barkham Parish and Wokingham to a point at Grid Reference 478674, 168030.  
 A bridleway commencing at Wokingham Footpath 1 to a point at Grid Reference 479227, 168092 and proceeding in a north-easterly direction along Limmerhill Road for 258 metres to a point at Grid Reference 479310, 168203 and continuing along Limmerhill Road in a generally south easterly direction for 625 metres to its junction with Barkham Road to a point at Grid Reference 479620, 167904.

### Description of paths or ways to be upgraded

Wokingham Footpath 1 commencing at Highlands Avenue at the boundary between Barkham Parish and Wokingham to a point at Grid Reference 478674, 168030 and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for 569 metres to a point at Grid Reference 478904, 168219. Status of the way is shown as a Footpath and is to be upgraded to a Bridleway.
