1. Can the Council's traffic cameras make video recordings?

No, recordings are not possible.

2. Does the Council have mobile traffic cameras?

No, the Council does not operate mobile traffic cameras.

3. On which dates was the traffic in Aldbourne Avenue and Ramsbury Drive surveyed in October 2024?

Aldbourne Avenue and Ramsbury Drive were surveyed on 16th, 17th and 19th October 2024.

4. On each day, how many vehicles travelled from the junction of Ramsbury Drive with Wilderness Drive to the junction of Aldbourne with Wokingham Road and vice versa in less than 6 minutes?
