

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

(WOKINGHAM FOOTPATHS WOKW5, WOKW9, WOKW10, WOKI24 & WOKI25)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

WHEREAS the Wokingham Borough Council (“the Council”) as Traffic Authority is satisfied that traffic on the said footpaths should be restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers **HEREBY MAKES** the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 26th November 2024 and may be cited as the Wokingham Borough Council (Wokingham Footpaths WOKW5, WOKW9, WOKW10, WOKI24 & WOKI25) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024.
2. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 8 hereof, no traffic shall proceed at any time along that part of public footpath WOKW5 from its junction with Easthampstead Road (marked point 'I' on the plan attached to this Order) to its connection with Waterloo Road (point J) for a length of approximately 620 metres as shown for identification purposes only coloured yellow on the plan attached to this Order.
3. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 8 hereof, no traffic shall proceed at any time along that part of public footpath WOKW9 from its junction with Gipsy Lane (point F) to its connection with public footpath WOKW9 at the Emm Brook (point E) for a length of approximately 200 metres as shown for identification purposes only coloured pink on the plan attached to this Order.
4. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 8 hereof, no traffic shall proceed at any time along that part of public footpath WOKW10 from its junction with Gipsy Lane (point G) to its connection with Ludgrove Road (point H) for a length of approximately 490 metres as shown for identification purposes only coloured brown on the plan attached to this Order.
5. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 8 hereof, no traffic shall proceed at any time along that part of public footpath WOKI24 from its connection with public footpath WOKW9 at the Emm Brook (point D) to its connection with public footpath WOKI25 (point C) for a length of approximately 190 metres as shown for identification purposes only coloured green on the plan attached to this Order.
6. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 8 hereof, no traffic shall proceed at any time along that part of public footpath WOKI25 from its junction with Finchampstead Road (point A) to its connection with Ludgrove Road (point B) for a length of approximately 680 metres as shown for identification purposes only coloured orange on the plan attached to this Order.
7. The restrictions contained in Articles 2,3,4,5 and 6 hereof shall not apply to any person proceeding by or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or to any person proceeding for any purpose in connection with the carrying out of the works.
8. The restrictions contained in Articles 2,3,4,5 and 6 hereof shall not apply to any person requiring access to properties only accessible from the said footpaths.
9. This Order shall come into operation on the 26th November 2024 and shall continue in force for a period of six months or until completion of the works whichever is the earlier.

6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of the provisions of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

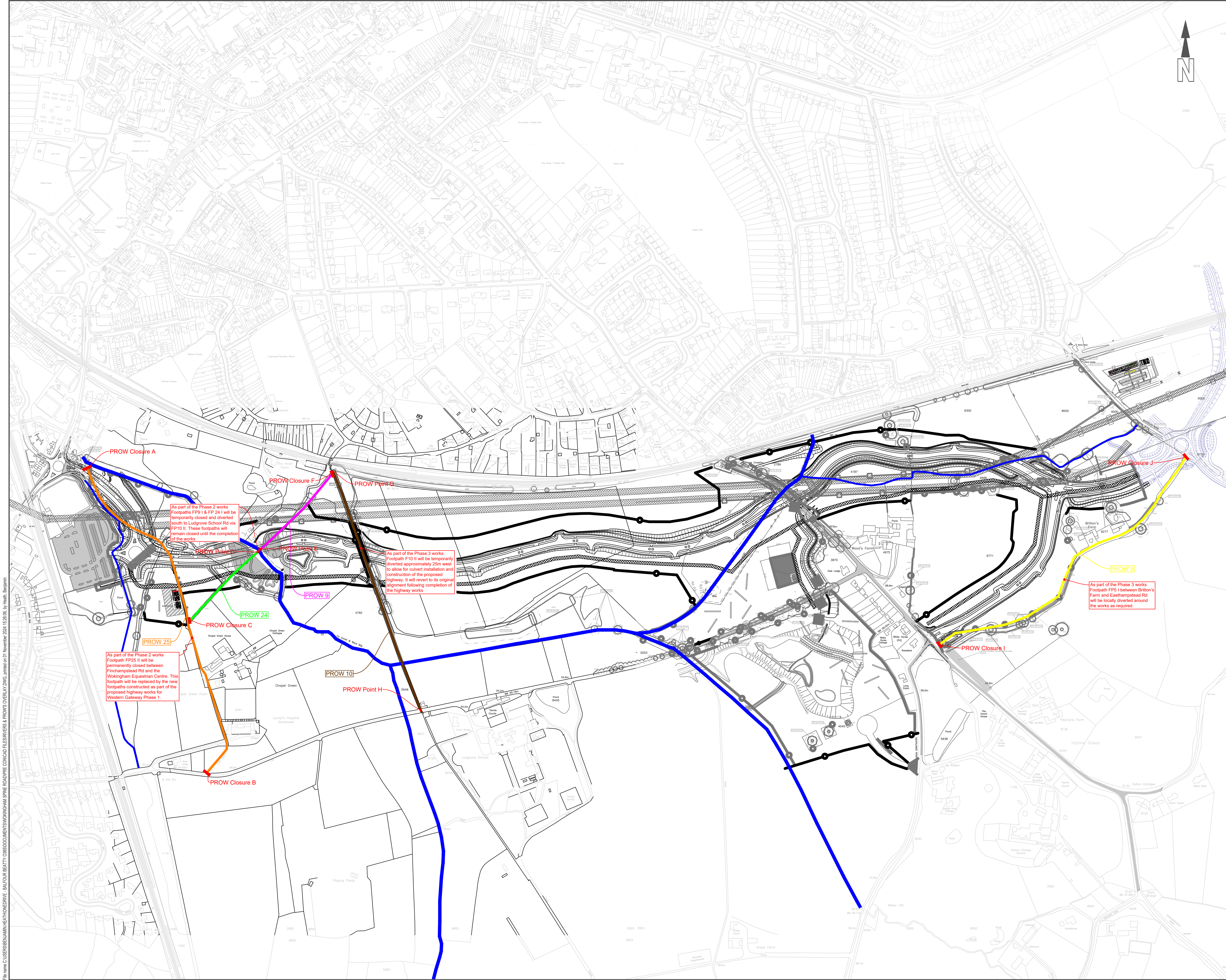

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council is satisfied that traffic on footpaths WOKI25, WOKI24, WOKW9, WOKW10 & WOKW5 should be temporarily restricted for the period specified in the Order in consideration of the proposed works to be executed on or nearby. The proposed works are tree / vegetation removal works, site clearance, utilities diversionary works and the construction of the South Wokingham Distributor Road, including earthworks, drainage, pavement construction, new road overbridge and pedestrian bridge across the Emm Brook, new culverts and diversions of watercourses. The temporary closure of the footpaths is necessary to allow these works to be undertaken in safety.
