MODIFICATION ORDER 2026

This Order is made by Wokingham Borough Council (“the Authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the 1981 Act”) because it appears to the Authority that the Wokingham Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 1 January 2000) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Carnival Place in Wokingham shown by a bold continuous red line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up from the date of confirmation of this Order and thereupon the Wokingham Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way (dated 1 January 2000) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. There shall be from the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situate at Carnival Place, Wokingham, described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken green line on the map contained in

this Order, and thereupon the Wokingham Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way (dated 1 January 2000) shall be modified by adding that footpath to it.
2A. The Wokingham Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 1 January 2000) shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING RIGHTS OF WAY

WOKINGHAM FOOTPATH 23

That part of Footpath 23 in the Parish of Wokingham Town which commences at SU80813 68294 (Point A on the plan) proceeding eastwards to SU80873 68364 (Point D on the plan)

Approximately 100 metres in length.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW RIGHT OF WAY

WOKINGHAM FOOTPATH 23

A path in the Parish of Wokingham Town which commences at SU80813 68294 (Point A on the plan) proceeding approximately 40 metres southwards along the walkway between Carnival Place flats and Carnival Place Car Park to SU80837 68272 (Point B on the plan), then approximately 90 metres eastwards along the walkway between Carnival Place flats and Carnival Hub to SU80902 68333 (Point C on the plan) on Wellington Road

Approximately 130 metres in length.

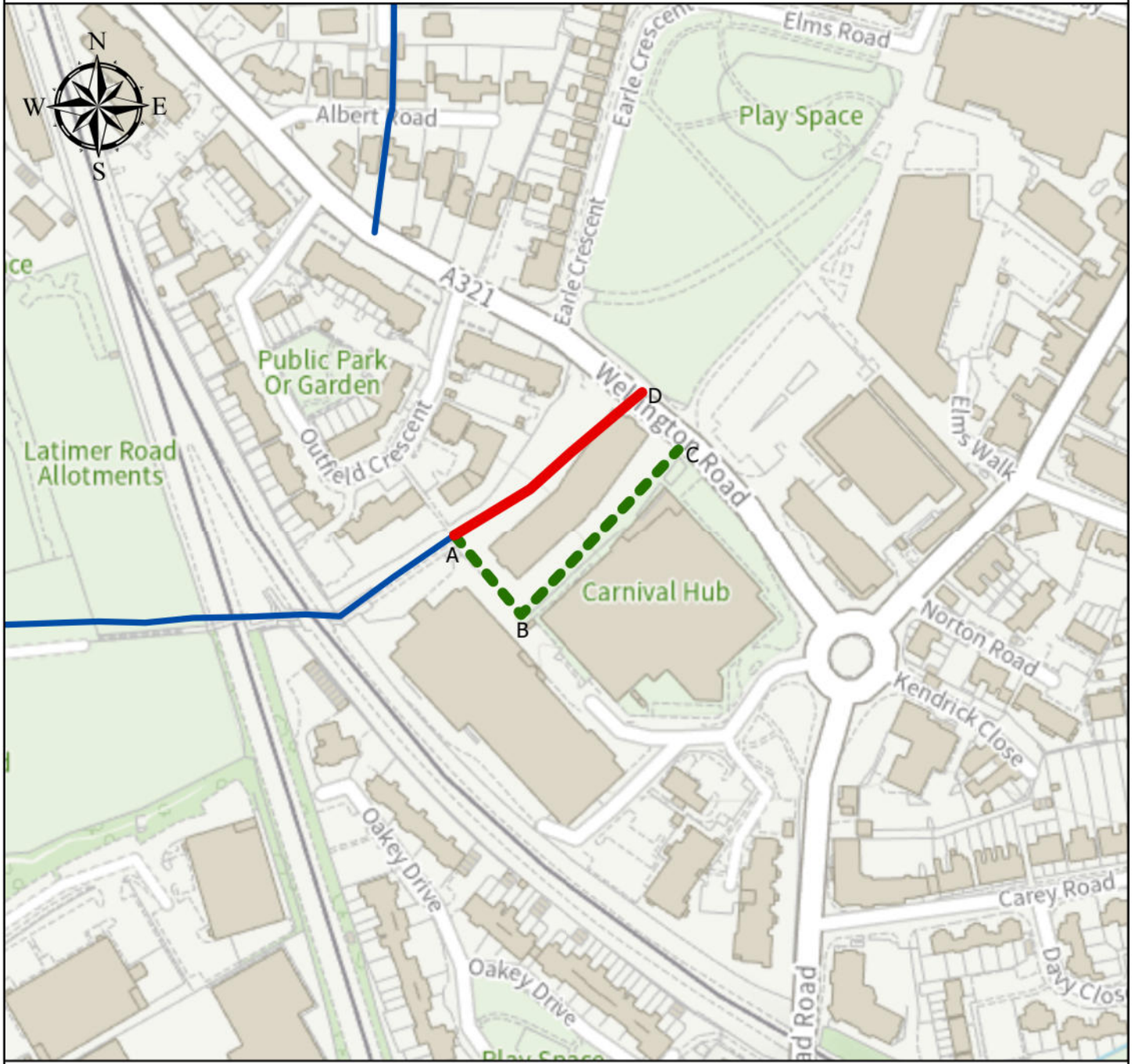

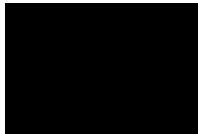
