

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**WOKINGHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL**

**(COLLETON DRIVE, WESSEX GARDENS AND WOODPECKER CLOSE,
TWYFORD)**

(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING) ORDER 2002

Wokingham District Council as Traffic Authority in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, HEREBY MAKES the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of July 2002 and shall be cited as the WOKINGHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL (COLLETON DRIVE, WESSEX GARDENS AND WOODPECKER CLOSE, TWYFORD)(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING) ORDER 2002.
2. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer or Traffic Warden in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads during the times specified in Schedules I and II of this Order.
3. No person shall except upon the direction of a Police Officer or a Traffic Warden in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop on the length of road during the times specified in Schedule III of this order.
4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads referred to in the Schedules I and II of this Order for as long as may be necessary to enable:
 - a) a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - b) a vehicle where it cannot conveniently be used in any other road to enable:
 - i) works of building or demolition to be carried out;
 - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads;
 - iv) the laying, erection or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of roads of any sewer or main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications.
 - c) a vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road in the service of a local authority or of any statutory authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- d) a vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packages as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
 - e) a vehicle to wait at or near any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of roads for as long as may be necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;
 - f) the vehicle to be used for police, fire services or ambulance purposes;
 - g) a vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in the provision of local service within the meaning of the Transport Act 1985;
 - h) goods to be loaded or unloaded from a vehicle.
5. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait in the lengths of roads described in the Schedule to this Order for not longer than a period of three hours subject to the condition set out in Article 6.
6. The condition referred to in Article 5 above is that a parking disc is displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle and that the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle marks on the parking disc the time at which the period of waiting has begun.
7. In this Order the expressions "disabled person's vehicle", "disabled person's badge" and "parking disc" shall have the meanings ascribed to them by the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons)(England and Wales) Regulations 1986 and its subsequent amendments.
8. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
9. This Order is made on the 31st day of May day of May 2002.

east side from a point 19 metres north of its junction with Woodpecker Close, southwards for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

west side from a point 95 metres south east of its junction with Winchcombe Road, south eastwards for a distance of approximately 33 metres.

Wessex Gardens

both sides from its junction with Colleton Drive, westwards for distance of approximately 19 metres.

Woodpecker Close

both sides from its junction with Colleton Drive, eastwards for a distance of approximately 19 metres.
